Hwe, sika a ɔtonn forest no, back door no, wagye sika no adi o, ena ɔde one million Ghana Cedis akoto aban fotoɔ mu. Na montie! Letter no dated 11th of June 2024. ɔse, "We acknowledge, we acknowledge receipt of an amount of One Million, (09:00) Four Hundred and Sixty-Five Thousand Ghana Cedis, Five Hundred Ghana Cedis via Forestry Commission official receipt number so-so and so, dated 10th June 2025 as Forest Entry Permit fee as well as copies of the mining operating permits, water use permit and environmental permit issued by the relevant regulatory authorities. 11th of June 2024, wose na woye Acting Chief Executive. Forest reserve biara ewo ha biara no, Mr Brown aton de ama galamseyfo agye sika no ahye ne botom; na ode ketewa bi ato Forestry Commission account mu. I am taking, just two documents, and the Forestry Commission, Acting Chief Executive who is the currently there. He is called Hugh C. A. Brown, Hugh C. A. Brown. If it's Huge or Hug, yes anything. C.A. Brown; Mr. Brown, Forestry Commission Acting Chief Executive Officer. When I put the documents in the public, it is then Ghana will see that we have National Security officers. We have a National Security Secretariat. (01:00) We will now know that Richard Gyakpa is not being selective, but he is doing his work to serve the nation, Ghana. Tomorrow, when these documents go out, then, we will know that the Director General, Bureau of National Investigation, is not selective but rather working to serve the nation, Ghana. When these documents go out, that is when we will see that EOCO Executive Secretary, Raymond Archer, is not being selective is not selective but is rather working for the nation Ghana. The Ghana Police Service, when someone forges documents, it is your duty, (02:00) but today this information is coming out, but if you are not able to arrest Mr. Brown, who is the Chief Executive Officer, Forestry Commission, then in the coming days there is no law that shows that when NDC does something wrong, we don't make arrest, but when NPP former appointees, you can go to their house and arrest them. I am coming to give a revelation by which people commit a crime and put it on someone. If God permits, this coming Monday, the Forestry Commission has set up a taskforce. *Elikplim Kotoko, the Deputy Chief Executive Officer, Forestry Commission. They were the ones who appeared on social media, and they told all the world's lie against Akuffo Addo.*

*They told all the world's lie against Bawumia. Monday, they are going for operations. The operations they are going as the Forestry Commission; the matter is simple. They are about to go to all the galamsey sites and when they finish, they will come out to do a press conference to say that all the galamsey sites they visited, it is during NPPs time that they were given mining lease to do galamsey, and that Ghanaians should blame NPP. They will shift the propaganda, they will shift the agenda onto the NPP. But if you plot, Ohia TV, we go everywhere; so, they will bring the information. Hey, as I move around, people know me, oh; people know me very well, oh. It could be that you'll be having a meeting and I will be seated among you. Unless you have eyes to see that this meeting we are holding Abronye is also part. Yes, when you are having the meeting someone can invite me to sit in, (05:00) saying that I should join and listen. (05:06) Now, the Chief Executive Officer who is at Forestry Commission has forged documents and blamed it on the NPP. Now, listen! We all know that when we were in government, the person who was the Forestry Commission, Chief Executive, he was called John Allotey. John Allotey brought his work to an end in January 2025. Listen to it very well! John Allotey as a Forestry Chief Executive brought his work to an end in January 2025. John Allotey took over when Sir John died in 2020; (06:00) it was October 2020, when either July or so, John Allotey took over as the Chief Executive, and he brought his work to an end in January 2025. But Brown, Mr. Brown, who is the current Chief Executive Officer for Forestry Commission has gone and written a letter dated 11th June 2024. Ehee, things will happen in this country! When Allotey was the Chief Executive, June 11th, 2024, the person who was the Chief Executive was John Allotey. As I speak with you, Brown, Hugh C.A. Brown has signed a letter and backdated it. But the crime he was committing, (07:00) you don't know you are committing a crime, so you will forget something. When he was backdating the letter to go and commit a crime, the letter is 11th June 2024 when he finished, he signed as Hugh C.A. Brown (PhD), Acting Executive. But the question this evening to all those watching; the Forestry Commission, who was the Chief Executive Officer in the year 2024? Forestry Commission, put the names under the comment section for me. (08:00) Put the names there; the person you know as the Chief Executive Officer. Put the name under the comments; 2024, 2024 June; if you know for 2024 the person who was the Forestry Commission Chief Executive Officer, put the name wherever you are watching from put it under the comment section for me. Mr. C.A. Brown, C.A. Brown was appointed January 2025. Today, CA Brown has signed a letter, 11th of June 2024, claiming that at that time, he was the Acting Chief Executive. You see, you have been caught! Do you know why he backdated the letter? If you take Gyamena Forest, the forest reserve that has been there over the years, the man, when he was made Chief Executive, has sold the forest and taken money. Look, the money when he sold the forest, through the back door and has taken the money for himself and he has put only one million Ghana Cedis into the government account. You all, listen! The letter dated 11th of June 2024. It reads, "We acknowledge We acknowledge receipt of an amount of One Million, (09:00) Four Hundred and Sixty-Five*

Did Nana Addo appoint you? You see, I have caught him. Put out things there. The letter is there. Mr. C.A. Brown, Forestry Commission Chief Executive, you could write a letter, backdated it to 2024 and claim that you were the Acting Chief Executive. What kind of thievery, what kind of forgery is that? (10:00) But National Security said they would not arrest him. He is an NDC member. BNI said they would not arrest him. Chief Executive Officer who is involved in forgery; the BNI said they won't arrest him. The EOCO said they won't arrest him. The Ghana Police Service said they won't arrest him. Rather someone who is in bed, an innocent person, who is treating his sickness abroad, you said they should go and kill him abroad. Ken Ofori Atta, who has committed no crime, you say he must come for you to kill him. Someone lives in the country, Mr C. A. Brown, Forestry Commission, Acting Chief Executive; a letter dated 11th June 2024, reference number FRA62/51, the end is 46. It reads, "The Acting Executive Director, Forestry Service Division... (11:00) when he finished, he gave references; Jimira Forest Reserve in Nkawie District in the Ashanti Region which is currently affected by illegal mining under the following:" And you have gone for the money and used it, and they have paid very little to the government. Today, he has sold the forest reserve. He has shared it to people for his own benefit. This is the letter. So, if someone can write a letter, the letter was not for (someone); it reads, "Mr C. A. Brown (PhD) Acting Executive, the letter is dated 11th June 2024". President John Dramani Mahama, His Excellency, John Dramani Mahama, His Excellency, John Dramani Mahama, you told Ghanaians that if members of your government (12:00) perpetuate crime, you would prosecute them first. I have brought before you; C. A. Brown, that C.A. Brown has forged a letter claiming to be the Chief Executive Officer, Acting Chief Executive Officer in 2024. In 2024! This is the evidence! This is the evidence I have given to you. Another letter, hey, C. A. Brown, listen oh; another letter, for that one too, he has gone and sold the forest again. He has sold another forest. C.A Brown has sold another forest in the same Ashanti Region. That one too, the letter is dated 16th May 2024. Approval for issuance of entry permit (13:00) for exploration, pre- mining operations. Brown has backdated the letter, Offinso Forest Reserve, he as backdated the letter, and written on it, 16th May 2024; that he C. A. Brown was the Acting Chief Executive. Look, he ended by saying, "We refer to the mining lease granted to Messrs. Ambi Ltd by the Honorable Minister for Lands and Natural Resources dated so- so and so- and -so , 2024 and subsequent request dated 18th March (14:00) for the issuance of Forest Entry Permit to undertake..." All these letters have been backdated, because, 2024 16th May, C.A. Brown, you were not the Forestry Commission Chief Executive. So, he was backdating all these so that after undertaking the operations and coming back, he would pretend that it happened under NPP regime. But for these letters, do you realise because he was committing a crime, he has forgotten that at that time, we had a Chief

Executive Officer who was called John Allotey; when you, Mr Brown, were not even a deputy. You were not even a Deputy Chief Executive Officer. However, the letters you have written, you have been exposed! The BNI claims they cannot arrest him because he is a government appointee; if they arrest him, it will disgrace the government. (15:00) The things C.A. Brown is doing, the items on my table, he will run away. We are watching to see if the Ghana Police Service will take up this matter. We are watching to see what the National Security and the Presidency, we are watching what you will do. The manner C. A. Brown appointed himself as the Chief Executive Officer. One letter dated 11th June 2024, he claims to be the Acting Chief Executive Officer, at that time. Who appointed him? Allotey was here; so, what time did you assume that position as the Acting Chief Executive Officer? Another one dated 16th May 2024, you claimed to be, (17:00) this is the one going to the Offinso Forest Reserve Belt. You claimed to be the Acting Chief Executive Officer 16th May 2024, who appointed you? Because when you assumed the position, you have started selling the forest reserve. Every forest reserve here has been sold by Mr Brown to galamsayers and pocketed the money, while paying less to the account of the Forestry Commission. When he finishes, he will backdate the letter claiming to be... during the NPP regime, he was the Chief Executive Officer. Do you realise we have caught you? President Mahama, as for this, it is on your doorstep; a Chief Executive Officer is the one I have busted. Your Chief Executive Officer has been busted. Your Chief Executive Officer, a forest reserve, is a Chief Executive Officer who allocates various forest reserves to the galamsayers and collects money for himself. (18:01) And you are quiet that your Chief Executive Officer is releasing lands for people to do galamsey, then also forges a letter and backdates it to indicate he was the Acting Chief Executive Officer under NPP, and the National Security is aware but they say they will not make any comment about it; the BNI is aware but they say they will not make any comment about it; the Ghana Police is aware but they say they will not make any comment about it; the EOCO is aware but they say they will not make any comment about it; as for me, I will comment on it. And if you cover up this matter, then the National Security, we are informing you that, with this evidence, with this forgery, we are informing you that the spate of arrests will come to an end in this country. If you are not able to arrest Brown, then bear it in your mind that you cannot arrest any former appointee under Nana Adu Danquah Akufo Addo. I am telling you in plain language, because he is committing the crime of stealing by selling our future, generational lands, to galamsayers (19:00)

*and collecting his money and backdating things. What are you saying? The fighting, things that are happening at the Forestry Commission, by God's grace, you will hear from us. And I am taking this opportunity to thank Dr Alhaji. I am about to finish, as I said, at 7:30, and I will close exactly one hour later, because today's programme was a breaking news programme. By this opportunity, I'm thanking Alhaji Dr. Mahamudu Bawumia, for special contribution; his excellency, Dr. Dr. Alhaji Mahamudu Bawumia, weighty, weighty contribution supporting Ablekuma, urging all NPP members to come out and support Honourable Akua Afriyie. We thank him. (20:00) Similarly, my own brother, Dr Bryan Acheampong, has sent his support. Dr Bryan Acheampong too has done well, your support is gone. So, these two leaders, I'm taking this opportunity to thank you. The manner in which you are helping the widows, encouraging the NPP members, encouraging the people in Ablekuma by saying that the widow whose hand they are twisting, our leader, Dr. Bawumia, our leader, Bryan Acheampong, supporting the widow, and protecting her, we thank you. By God's grace, we will come and continue tomorrow. We will bring two executives from the polling station and the African Sanity Report, the Sanity Africa Report. They will also come and digest, for them to... when we went around, the interviews conducted, the people from the polling station (21:00) expressed their views; so, they will come to this studio tomorrow for us to ask them questions about the Sanity Africa Report that is circulating. So, tune in here tomorrow. We will bring two or three guests to this studio for them to share their views about the Sanity Africa Report on the NPP Presidential issue, which we will digest. After digesting, you will go on the weekend. We thank all of you. Be here tomorrow; this studio is for informational purposes. I have told you that we will continue from the Forestry Commission tomorrow. Any corruption occurring at the Forestry Commission will be exposed here tomorrow. We thank all of you"*

Statement of Claim

---

1. Plaintiff, a Ghanaian national, and presently the acting Chief Executive of the Forestry Commission (Commission) commenced working in the Commission in 1993 when he did his national service from September 1993 to August 1994. Plaintiff was retained and employed in the Commission (then Forestry Department) and has occupied various positions rising from a District Forest Officer from September 1995 to July 2004, Operations Manager from July 2004 to November 2012, Director of Operations from November 2012 to June 2022 and the Executive Director of the Forest Service Division from June 2022 to January 2025, until his recent appointment as acting Chief Executive Officer in January 2025.
2. Plaintiff, a chartered professional forester with over 30 (thirty) years' service in the Commission has achieved a number of academic laurels. He holds a PhD in Tropical Forest Ecology from the University of Helsinki, Finland, a Master's degree in Forestry from Yale University in the United States of America, a Master of Business Administration degree, and a Bachelor of Science degree from the Kwame Nkrumah University of Science and Technology, Ghana.
3. Plaintiff has in addition, published a number of scientific articles in some reputable scientific journals such as the Forest Ecology & Management, IFRO World Series, Gederma Regional, International Journal of applied Earth Observation and Geo information and also in the Current Forestry Reports.
4. Plaintiff belongs to a number of professional bodies including Ghana Institute of Foresters, Society of American Foresters, and Society of Ecological Restoration. Plaintiff is currently the Chairperson of the steering committee of TEAKNET, an international network of institutions, companies and individuals involved in the cultivation, research, harvesting, processing and marketing of

teak timber, and co-chairs with Indonesia the Broader Market Recognition Coalition (BMRC) for tropical timber producing countries advocating for national sustainable management systems.

5. Plaintiff says that by virtue of the positions he has occupied and presently occupies, he is well known both in Ghana and internationally as an accomplished professional and definitely not an embezzler, a dishonest and or fraudulent person and or a thief.
6. Defendant is presently the Bono Regional Chairman of the New Patriotic Party, the largest opposition party in Ghana and operates OHIA TV, an online television station.
7. Plaintiff says that OHIA TV has as its flagship programme, a show known as the "The Evidence", which is broadcast in English and Twi language. Whilst English language is the official language of Ghana and also a language which is globally spoken and or understood, Twi language is either spoken and or understood by a significant majority of persons living and or residing in Ghana and or of Ghanaian heritage or parentage worldwide.
8. Plaintiff adds that by virtue of OHIA TV being on internet platforms such as Facebook, Youtube, and TikTok, it (OHIA TV) has a permanent presence worldwide and all its programmes are broadcast to the whole wide world and can be accessed on any smart electronic device including mobile phones and tablets.
9. Plaintiff says that on or about the 10<sup>th</sup> day of July 2025, Defendant caused to be broadcast and published, the following defamatory words in a mixture of Twi and English:

Ɔwieeyɛ a na wabackdate letter no sɛ ɛyɛ NPP pɛn so, na na ɔyɛ Chief Executive Officer. Wonhu se yɛakye wo? President Mahama, wei deɛ, wo kwan ano o; a Chief Executive Officer ɛna mabust no yi! Your Chief Executive Officer has been busted. Enti yɛatumi akye wo Chief Executive a, forest reserve Chief Executive Officer a various forest reserves no na ɔde rema galamsayfoɔ de regye sika die. And you are quiet about sɛ your Chief Executive Officer ɛde forest*

no rema nkurofoɔ ye galamsey dee a, esane (18:01) forge letter, backdate letter no se na ɔye Acting Chief Executive Officer under NPP, na National Security ye aware, wɔɔmo se yenka ho, BNI ye aware wɔɔmo se yenka ho asem; Ghana Police ye aware, wɔɔmo se yenka ho asem; EOCO ye aware, wɔɔmo se yenka ho asem; me dee, meka ho asem. Na se mokata saa asem wei so dee a, National Securityfoɔ, yereka akyerɛ mo se with this evidence, with this forgery no, yereka akyerɛ mo se akyekyerɛakyekyerɛ no beba awieye wɔ kurom ha. Se moantumi ankye Brown, momfa nhye wo tirim se montumi nkye any former appointee under Nana Ado Danquah Akufo Addo. Mereka akyerɛ mo plain, because korɔnoo ena ɔrebo, ena ɔretɔn yen daakye, nkyirimma asaase ede ama galamsayfoɔ (19:00) na wagye ne sika kɔ na ɔrebackdate nneema. Mose sen?

Merefa akwanya wei so na mada Dr. Alhaji Mahamudu Bawumia ase, contribution soronko; his excellency, Dr. Dr. Alhaji Mahamudu Bawumia, contribution a emu ye duru, a emu ye duru, a ɔde asupport Ablekuma, se NPP mma nyinaa mpue na wɔɔmo nkɔsupport Honourable Akua Afriyie. Yeda no ase. (20:00) Saa nso na me ara me nua, Dr. Bryan Acheampong nso, de ne support kɔ. Dr. Bryan Acheampong nso aye adee, wo support kɔ. Nti saa mpanimfoɔ yi mmienu yi, merefa akwanya yi so ma mada mo ase.

Ekwan a moreboa se ebeye a kunafoɔ no, morehye NPP mma nkuran, morehye amanfoɔ a ewɔ Ablekuma se kunafoɔ no a wɔɔmo rekyinkyim ne nsa no, yen wura, Dr. Bawumia, yen wura, Bryan Acheampong, mogyina kunafoɔ no akyi, rebɔ no kyidɔm, yeda mo ase. Nyame ye adom a, ɔkyena yebeba abetɔa so. Yede polling station executives mmienu bi beba na Africa Sanity Report no, Sanity Africa Report no, wɔɔmo nso abedigest, wɔɔmo nso no, interviews a yekɔɔ rounds, polling stationfoɔ yi kyereɛ wɔɔmo adwene; (21:00) enti ɔkyena, wɔɔmo beba fie ha, na Sanity Africa Report no a ereko rounds no, yabisa wɔɔmo kosa kosa. Enti ɔkyena, fa w'afidie no to ha. Yede guests mmienu mmiensa beba fia ha na wɔɔmo nso abeto wɔɔmo anum tuo efa Sanity Africa Report no a ereko round fa NPP Presidential ayi, na yeadigest. Yedigest wie a na, mode kɔ weekend. Yeda mo nyinaa ase. Montena eha ɔkyena, information fie ne no. Mede abre mo se ɔkyena yebetoa so firi Forestry Commission. Dwirim biara a ereko so wɔ Forestry Commission ɔkyena, ebepue mu wɔ ha. Yeda mo nyinaa ase."

10. The words translated in English are as follows:-

"Commission, I have initially said that the document I am bringing out, I am taking only two out for tomorrow Friday; we will work mercilessly. I am taking, just two documents, and the Forestry Commission, Acting Chief Executive who is the currently there. He is called Hugh C. A. Brown, Hugh C. A. Brown. If it's Huge or Hug, yes anything. C.A. Brown; Mr. Brown, Forestry Commission Acting Chief Executive Officer. When I put the documents in the public, it is then Ghana will see that we have National Security officers. We have a National Security Secretariat. (01:00) We will now know that Richard Gyakpa is not being selective, but he is doing his

work to serve the nation, Ghana. Tomorrow, when these documents go out, then, we will know that the Director General, Bureau of National Investigation, is not selective but rather working to serve the nation, Ghana. When these documents go out, that is when we will see that EOCO Executive Secretary, Raymond Archer, is not being selective is not selective but is rather working for the nation Ghana. The Ghana Police Service, when someone forges documents, it is your duty, (02:00) but today this information is coming out, but if you are not able to arrest Mr. Brown, who is the Chief Executive Officer, Forestry Commission, then in the coming days there is no law that shows that when NDC does something wrong, we don't make arrest, but when NPP former appointees, you can go to their house and arrest them. I am coming to give a revelation by which people commit a crime and put it on someone. If God permits, this coming Monday, the Forestry Commission has set up a taskforce. The prime meeting they held indoors was that the taskforce will go rounds. They will start going to galamsey sites. When they are done with all the galamsey sites, they will come (03:00) and hold a press conference and say the taskforce is being led by the Deputy Executive Officer called Eklem Kotoko. Ekleplim Kotoko; erh Eklip Kotoko, who and who; Kotoko; he is called Eklim, Kplim Kototo. Those who know the name, send it to me. The Deputy Chief Executive Officer; if God permits, on the 13th of July, this coming Monday, (04:00) they are going to conduct operations, Monday is 14th rather. Yeah. 14th, this coming Monday, Elikplim Kotoko, the Deputy Chief Executive Officer, Forestry Commission. They were the ones who appeared on social media, and they told all the world's lie against Akuffo Addo.

They told all the world's lie against Bawumia. Monday, they are going for operations. The operations they are going as the Forestry Commission; the matter is simple. They are about to go to all the galamsey sites and when they finish, they will come out to do a press conference to say that all the galamsey sites they visited, it is during NPPs time that they were given mining lease to do galamsey, and that Ghanaians should blame NPP. They will shift the propaganda, they will shift the agenda onto the NPP. But if you plot, Ohia TV, we go everywhere; so, they will bring the information. Hey, as I move around, people know me, oh; people know me very well, oh. It could be that you'll be having a meeting and I will be seated among you. Unless you have eyes to see that this meeting we are holding Abronye is also part. Yes, when you are having the meeting someone can invite me to sit in, (05:00) saying that I should join and listen. (05:06) Now, the Chief Executive Officer who is at Forestry Commission has forged documents and blamed it on the NPP. Now, listen! We all know that when we were in government, the person who was the Forestry Commission, Chief Executive, he was called John Allotey. John Allotey brought his work to an end in January 2025. Listen to it very well! John Allotey as a Forestry Chief Executive brought his work to an end in January 2025. John Allotey took over when Sir John died in 2020; (06:00) it was October 2020, when either July or so, John Allotey took over as the Chief Executive, and he brought his work to an end in January 2025. But Brown, Mr. Brown, who is the current Chief Executive Officer for Forestry Commission has gone and written a letter dated 11th June 2024. Ehee, things will happen in this country! When Allotey was the Chief Executive, June 11th, 2024, the person who was the Chief Executive was John

Allotey. As I speak with you, Brown, Hugh C.A. Brown has signed a letter and backdated it. But the crime he was committing, (07:00) you don't know you are committing a crime, so you will forget something. When he was backdating the letter to go and commit a crime, the letter is 11th June 2024 when he finished, he signed as Hugh C.A. Brown (PhD), Acting Executive. But the question this evening to all those watching; the Forestry Commission, who was the Chief Executive Officer in the year 2024? Forestry Commission, put the names under the comment section for me. (08:00) Put the names there; the person you know as the Chief Executive Officer. Put the name under the comments; 2024, 2024 June; if you know for 2024 the person who was the Forestry Commission Chief Executive Officer, put the name wherever you are watching from put it under the comment section for me. Mr. C.A. Brown, C.A. Brown was appointed January 2025. Today, CA Brown has signed a letter, 11th of June 2024, claiming that at that time, he was the Acting Chief Executive. You see, you have been caught! Do you know why he backdated the letter? If you take Jimira Jimira Forest, the forest reserve that has been there over the years, the man, when he was made Chief Executive, has sold the forest and taken money. Look, the money when he sold the forest, through the back door and has taken the money for himself and he has put only one million Ghana Cedis into the government account. You all, listen! The letter dated 11th of June 2024. It reads, "We acknowledge We acknowledge receipt of an amount of One Million, (09:00) Four Hundred and Sixty-Five Thousand, Five Hundred Ghana Cedis via Forestry Commission number official receipt number so-so and so, dated 10th June 2025 as Forest Entry Permit fee as well as copies of the mining operating permits, water use permit and environmental permit issued by the relevance regulatory authorities. 11th of June 2024, you claim you were the Acting Chief Executive. Did Nana Addo appoint you? You see, I have caught him. Put out things there. The letter is there. Mr. C.A. Brown, Forestry Commission Chief Executive, you could write a letter, backdated it to 2024 and claim that you were the Acting Chief Executive. What kind of thievery, what kind of forgery is that? (10:00) But National Security said they would not arrest him. He is an NDC member. BNI said they would not arrest him. Chief Executive Officer who is involved in forgery; the BNI said they won't arrest him. The EOCO said they won't arrest him. The Ghana Police Service said they won't arrest him. Rather someone who is in bed, an innocent person, who is treating his sickness abroad, you said they should go and kill him abroad. Ken Ofori Atta, who has committed no crime, you say he must come for you to kill him. Someone lives in the country, Mr C. A. Brown, Forestry Commission, Acting Chief Executive; a letter dated 11th June 2024, reference number FRA62/51, the end is 46. It reads, "The Acting Executive Director, Forestry Service Division... (11:00) when he finished, he gave references; Jimira Forest Reserve in Nkawie District in the Ashanti Region which is currently affected by illegal mining under the following:" And you have gone for the money and used it, and they have paid very little to the government. Today, he has sold the forest reserve. He has shared it to people for his own benefit. This is the letter. So, if someone can write a letter, the letter was not for (someone); it reads, "Mr C. A. Brown (PhD) Acting Executive, the letter is dated 11th June 2024". President John Dramani Mahama, His Excellency, John Dramani Mahama, His Excellency, John Dramani Mahama, you told Ghanaians that if members of your government (12:00) perpetuate crime, you would

prosecute them first. I have brought before you; C. A. Brown, that C.A. Brown has forged a letter claiming to be the Chief Executive Officer, Acting Chief Executive Officer in 2024. In 2024! This is the evidence! This is the evidence I have given to you. Another letter, hey, C. A. Brown, listen oh; another letter, for that one too, he has gone and sold the forest again. He has sold another forest. C.A Brown has sold another forest in the same Ashanti Region. That one too, the letter is dated 16th May 2024. Approval for issuance of entry permit (13:00) for exploration, pre- mining operations. He ended by giving it to the Ambi Limited Concession of Offinso Share Bed Forest Reserve, Offinso. The Offinso Forest Reserve there, Mr C. A. Brown has backdated the letter; Mr C. A. Brown has backdated the letter, Offinso Forest Reserve, he as backdated the letter, and written on it, 16th May 2024; that he C. A. Brown was the Acting Chief Executive. Look, he ended by saying, "We refer to the mining lease granted to Messrs. Ambi Ltd by the Honorable Minister for Lands and Natural Resources dated so- so and so- and -so , 2024 and subsequent request dated 18th March (14:00) for the issuance of Forest Entry Permit to undertake..." All these letters have been backdated, because, 2024 16th May, C.A. Brown, you were not the Forestry Commission Chief Executive. So, he was backdating all these so that after undertaking the operations and coming back, he would pretend that it happened under NPP regime. But for these letters, do you realise because he was committing a crime, he has forgotten that at that time, we had a Chief Executive Officer who was called John Allotey; when you, Mr Brown, were not even a deputy. You were not even a Deputy Chief Executive Officer. However, the letters you have written, you have been exposed! The BNI claims they cannot arrest him because he is a government appointee; if they arrest him, it will disgrace the government. (15:00) The things C.A. Brown is doing, the items on my table, he will run away. If the government claims, or the BNI claims, that they won't arrest him for the crimes he is committing, here and the letters he is backdating to 2024, in order to implicate the NPP. That he can backdate a letter to the effect that under Nana Akuffo Addo, he was the Chief Executive, National Security is aware. BNI is aware; EOCO is aware; Ghana Police Service is aware. They claim he is the President's appointee; therefore, he is untouchable. So, when he finishes doing this, you hear tomorrow that let's go and arrest a former appointee; maybe let's go and arrest the lands minister, Honourable Abu Jinapor; let's go and arrest him. You will be there and hear that tomorrow, let's go and arrest the former (16:00) Forestry Commission Chief Executive Officer, John Allotey. Not knowing it is the person who has come, has backdated a letter to indicate that he was the Chief Executive Officer. We are watching! We are watching to see if the BNI will take up this matter. We are watching to see if the Ghana Police Service will take up this matter. We are watching to see what the National Security and the Presidency, we are watching what you will do. The manner C. A. Brown appointed himself as the Chief Executive Officer. One letter dated 11th June 2024, he claims to be the Acting Chief Executive Officer, at that time. Who appointed him? Allotey was here; so, what time did you assume that position as the Acting Chief Executive Officer? Another one dated 16th May 2024, you claimed to be, (17:00) this is the one going to the Offinso Forest Reserve Belt. You claimed to be the Acting Chief Executive Officer 16th May 2024, who appointed you? Because when you assumed the position, you have started selling the forest reserve. Every forest reserve

here has been sold by Mr Brown to galamsayers and pocketed the money, while paying less to the account of the Forestry Commission. When he finishes, he will backdate the letter claiming to be... during the NPP regime, he was the Chief Executive Officer. Do you realise we have caught you? President Mahama, as for this, it is on your doorstep; a Chief Executive Officer is the one I have busted. Your Chief Executive Officer has been busted. Your Chief Executive Officer, a forest reserve, is a Chief Executive Officer who allocates various forest reserves to the galamsayers and collects money for himself. (18:01) And you are quiet that your Chief Executive Officer is releasing lands for people to do galamsey, then also forges a letter and backdates it to indicate he was the Acting Chief Executive Officer under NPP, and the National Security is aware but they say they will not make any comment about it; the BNI is aware but they say they will not make any comment about it; the Ghana Police is aware but they say they will not make any comment about it; the EOCO is aware but they say they will not make any comment about it; as for me, I will comment on it. And if you cover up this matter, then the National Security, we are informing you that, with this evidence, with this forgery, we are informing you that the spate of arrests will come to an end in this country. If you are not able to arrest Brown, then bear it in your mind that you cannot arrest any former appointee under Nana Adu Donkor Akufo Addo. I am telling you in plain language, because he is committing the crime of stealing by selling our future, generational lands, to galamsayers (19:00) and collecting his money and backdating things. What are you saying? The fighting, things that are happening at the Forestry Commission, by God's grace, you will hear from us. And I am taking this opportunity to thank Dr Alhaji. I am about to finish, as I said, at 7:30, and I will close exactly one hour later, because today's programme was a breaking news programme. By this opportunity, I'm thanking Alhaji Dr. Mahamudu Bawumia, for special contribution; his Excellency, Dr. Dr. Alhaji Mahamudu Bawumia, weighty, weighty contribution supporting Ablekuma, urging all NPP members to come out and support Honourable Akua Afriyie. We thank him. (20:00) Similarly, my own brother, Dr Bryan Acheampong, has sent his support. Dr Bryan Acheampong too has done well, your support is gone. So, these two leaders, I'm taking this opportunity to thank you. The manner in which you are helping the widows, encouraging the NPP members, encouraging the people in Ablekuma by saying that the widow whose hand they are twisting, our leader, Dr. Bawumia, our leader, Bryan Acheampong, supporting the widow, and protecting her, we thank you. By God's grace, we will come and continue tomorrow. We will bring two executives from the polling station and the African Sanity Report, the Sanity Africa Report. They will also come and digest, for them to... when we went around, the interviews conducted, the people from the polling station (21:00) expressed their views; so, they will come to this studio tomorrow for us to ask them questions about the Sanity Africa Report that is circulating. So, tune in here tomorrow. We will bring two or three guests to this studio for them to share their views about the Sanity Africa Report on the NPP Presidential issue, which we will digest. After digesting, you will go on the weekend. We thank all of you. Be here tomorrow; this studio is for informational purposes. I have told you that we will continue from the Forestry Commission tomorrow. Any corruption occurring at the Forestry Commission will be exposed here tomorrow. We thank all of you."

11. Plaintiff says that the words in the publications, particulars of which are stated in paragraphs 9 and 10 supra, meant and were understood to mean that:
  - a) Plaintiff is a dishonest person who has fraudulently backdated a letter to 11<sup>th</sup> June 2024 and sold a forest reserve.
  - b) Plaintiff is a criminal who has fraudulently sold Jimira Forest Reserve.
  - c) Plaintiff is in addition, a thief who after wrongfully and or fraudulently selling Jimira Forest Reserve, kept all the proceeds and paid a paltry sum of GH¢1,465,500.00 (One Million, Four Hundred and Sixty-Five Thousand, Five Hundred Ghana Cedis) to the Forestry Commission.
  - d) Plaintiff is a thief who has sold Jimira Forest Reserve to Galamseyers (illegal miners).
  - e) Plaintiff has granted entry permits to persons to undertake illegal mining.
  - f) Plaintiff deserves to be arrested for his crimes but the police, BNI together with the various security agencies are refusing to arrest him due to his (Plaintiff's) political connection.
12. Plaintiff denies that he engaged in wrongful act(s) and states that he has not acted illegally and or fraudulently in any way whatsoever and or howsoever.
13. Plaintiff states that the letters referred to in the broadcast were approvals granted by him (Plaintiff) to the Executive Director, Forest Services Division, and not the actual entry permits, which are the preserve of the Executive Director of the Forest Services Division.
14. The approvals referred to in the 4 (four) separate letters were effected in line with existing laws and following due consultation with the sector minister, who was officially copied in each case and the said letters were not written covertly.
15. Plaintiff states that the Forestry Commission in a rejoinder dated the 14<sup>th</sup> day of July 2025 and issued by its Corporate Affairs & Media Relations Unit explained that the year '2024' in the letters referred to by Defendant in his publication was an error and should have read '2025'.
16. The rejoinder further explained the circumstances under which the letters were written and debunked any notion of any fraud, thievery and wrongful act on Plaintiff's part. The rejoinder is explicit that there has not been any sale of the Jimira and Offin Shelterbelt Forest Reserves and that the state has not suffered any loss of revenue.
17. Plaintiff states that Defendant was sent a copy of this rejoinder by WhatsApp on his number '020 808 1484'. On receipt of the rejoinder, Defendant replied by not only rebuffing the rejoinder but also, by stating that the rejoinder was '*Absolutely balderdash*', which message was sent at 11:50am on Monday, the 14<sup>th</sup> day of July 2025.
18. By reason of the publications of the said words and also the graphic broadcast particulars of which are contained in paragraphs 9 and 10, Plaintiff has been

seriously injured in his reputation and has been brought into public scandal, odium, and contempt.

19. Since the publication and broadcast, Plaintiff has been inundated with numerous calls and has had to answer very embarrassing questions and inquiries from different people, including colleagues, business associates, and professional colleagues worldwide together with friends and acquaintances both in Ghana and abroad.
20. Plaintiff contends that the Defendant acted maliciously in publishing and broadcasting the said defamatory words, which were designed to cause hatred, ridicule and public odium and has also tarnished Plaintiff's hard-earned reputation in Ghana and abroad. Defendant knew and or ought to have known that his publication would cause maximum damage, especially when he (Defendant) states as a fact that Plaintiff had stolen money, sold the Jimira Forest Reserve, and also engaged in criminal acts of forgery and or backdating of letters with the intent to commit crime and committing the crime of forgery.
21. Plaintiff will contend that Defendant's conduct in publishing and broadcasting the said defamatory broadcast and publication was malicious and deliberate to cause more injury to Plaintiff, in that before the publication Defendant was, and or should have been aware that the publication and broadcast could not be true.

Particulars of Malice

- a) Defendant deliberately caused the said broadcast and publication to be made at prime time and on the flagship programme of OHIA TV to ensure that this broadcast and publication would be viewed nationwide and intended same to have maximum effect on its viewers in Ghana.
  - b) A simple enquiry and or investigation by Defendant from Plaintiff and or the Forestry Commission will have shown that there was no truth in the facts which formed the basis of the wrongful publication.
  - c) Defendants knew and or ought to have known that Plaintiff has not sold and or cannot sell any Forest Reserve in Ghana but boldly and strenuously made statements to the effect that Plaintiff had sold the Jimira Forest Reserve, an act which if true is a criminal act.
22. Plaintiff will rely on the following facts and matters in support of his claim for exemplary damages:
- a) That the broadcast and publication was made in a sensational manner at prime time and Defendant fabricated the facts of Plaintiff having sold and kept money from the proceeds of the alleged criminal act of selling a Forest Reserve, knowing very well that it is impossible for Plaintiff to sell a Forest Reserve.
  - b) Defendant deliberately published and broadcast the alleged criminal sale of the Jimira Forest Reserve and stealing of the proceeds of the illegal sale to maintain and increase the viewership and listenership of the said OHIA TV and visitors to the website and or social media pages of OHIA

TV. It was also to ensure that Defendant gains visitors to the internet website and or platforms of OHIA TV so as to be attractive to advertisers and thereby increase revenue. Defendant acted with reckless disregard for the truth of the broadcast and publication.

- c) Defendant who is the Bono Regional Chairman of the New Patriotic Party deliberately caused this publication to increase his influence and standing in the New Patriotic Party as a person who specialises in heaping unprintable and defamatory words.

23. Plaintiff will contend that Defendant published and broadcast the said words with the knowledge that he was being reckless and or with reckless disregard as to whether or not they were libellous.

24. Plaintiff says that unless restrained by this Honourable Court, Defendant will continue to publish and broadcast the said words complained of and or similar words as those complained of, particulars of which are contained in paragraphs 9 and 10 supra.

25. Wherefore, Plaintiff claims against the Defendant for:

- a) Perpetual injunction restraining the Defendant either by himself or his agents or assigns from further publishing and or broadcasting and or distributing films and or videos containing the following defamatory words or like words and specifically the following:

*"Commission, madi kan aka se documents yi a medereba abɔntene yi no, mereyi mmienu pe na ɔkyena Fie [Fiadaɔ, yɛbɛyɛ adwuma basabasa. Mereyi, just two documents, na Forestry Commission, Acting Chief Executive a ɔwɔ hɔ seisei. Yɛfrɛ no Hugh C. A. Brown, Hugh C. A. Brown. Se Hugu, se Hug, yes, biara, C.A. Brown; Mr. Brown, Forestry Commission Acting Chief Executive Officer. Mede documents no to dwa wie a, afei na Ghana yerebehunu se yɛwɔ National Security officers. Yɛwɔ National Security Secretariat.*

*(01:00) Afei na yerebehunu se Richard Gyakpa enye selective na ɔreyɛ, na mmon ɔreyɛ n'adwuma de asom ɔman Ghana. ɔkyena, documents wei ko abɔnten wie a, ena yerebehunu se the Director General, Bureau of National Investigation, ɔnye selective na mmon ɔreyɛ adwuma de asom ɔman Ghana. Documents wei ko abɔnten a, ena yerebehunu se EOCO Executive Secretary, Raymond Archer, ɔnye selective, ɔnye selective na mmom ɔreyɛ adwuma de ama ɔman Ghana. The Ghana Police Service, obi forge documents a, eye mo duty, (02:00) na nne information wei reba, na se moantumi arrest Mr. Brown a ɔye Chief Executive Officer, Forestry Commission, dee a, ennee in the coming days no, there is no law a ekyere se NDC ye bɔne a yenkye, na mmom, NPP former appointees dee, motumi ko wɔwɔ fie ekɔkye wɔwɔ.*

Not knowing it is the person who has come, has backdated a letter to indicate that he was the Chief Executive Officer. We are watching! We are watching to see if the BNI will take up this matter. We are watching to see if the Ghana Police Service will take up this matter. We are watching to see what the National Security and the Presidency, we are watching what you will do. The manner C. A. Brown appointed himself as the Chief Executive Officer. One letter dated 11th June 2024, he claims to be the Acting Chief Executive Officer, at that time. Who appointed him? Allotey was here; so, what time did you assume that position as the Acting Chief Executive Officer? Another one dated 16th May 2024, you claimed to be, (17:00) this is the one going to the Offinso Forest Reserve Belt. You claimed to be the Acting Chief Executive Officer 16th May 2024, who appointed you? Because when you assumed the position, you have started selling the forest reserve. Every forest reserve here has been sold by Mr Brown to galamsayers and pocketed the money, while paying less to the account of the Forestry Commission. When he finishes, he will backdate the letter claiming to be... during the NPP regime, he was the Chief Executive Officer. Do you realise we have caught

you? President Mahama, as for this, it is on your doorstep; a Chief Executive Officer is the one I have busted. Your Chief Executive Officer has been busted. Your Chief Executive Officer, a forest reserve, is a Chief Executive Officer who allocates various forest reserves to the galamsayers and collects money for himself. (18:01) And you are quiet that your Chief Executive Officer is releasing lands for people to do galamsey, then also forges a letter and backdates it to indicate he was the Acting Chief Executive Officer under NPP, and the National Security is aware but they say they will not make any comment about it; the BNI is aware but they say they will not make any comment about it; the Ghana Police is aware but they say they will not make any comment about it; the EOCO is aware but they say they will not make any comment about it; as for me, I will comment on it. And if you cover up this matter, then the National Security, we are informing you that, with this evidence, with this forgery, we are informing you that the spate of arrests will come to an end in this country. If you are not able to arrest Brown, then bear it in your mind that you cannot arrest any former appointee under Nana Adu Donkor. I am telling you in plain language, because he is committing the crime of stealing by selling our future, generational lands, to galamsayers (19:00) and collecting his money and backdating things. What are you saying? The fighting, things that are happening at the Forestry Commission, by God's grace, you will hear from us. And I am taking this opportunity to thank Dr Alhaji. I am about to finish, as I said, at 7:30, and I will close exactly one hour later, because today's programme was a breaking news programme. So, these two leaders, I'm taking this opportunity to thank you. The manner in which you are helping the widows, encouraging the NPP members, encouraging the people in Ablekuma by saying that the widow whose hand they are twisting, our leader, Dr. Bawumia, our leader, Bryan Acheampong, supporting the widow, and protecting her, we thank you. By God's grace, we will come and continue tomorrow. We will bring two executives from the polling station and the African Sanity Report, the Sanity Africa Report. They will also come and digest, for them to... when we went around, the interviews conducted, the people from the polling station (21:00) expressed their views; so, they will come to this studio tomorrow for us to ask them questions about the Sanity Africa Report that is circulating. So, tune in here tomorrow. We will bring two or three guests to this studio for them to share their views about the Sanity Africa Report on the NPP Presidential issue, which we will digest. After digesting, you will go on the weekend. We thank all of you. Be here tomorrow; this studio is for informational purposes. I have told you that we will continue from the Forestry Commission tomorrow. Any corruption occurring at the Forestry Commission will be exposed here tomorrow. We thank all of you."

- e) A retraction and apology 6 (six) consecutive times on Ghana Television (GTV), TV3, JOY TV, and OHIA TV, a written publication on the website and or platforms of OHIA TV and JOY TV, together with 4 (four) publications on the front and back pages of the Daily Graphic Newspaper for 4 (four) consecutive weeks.
